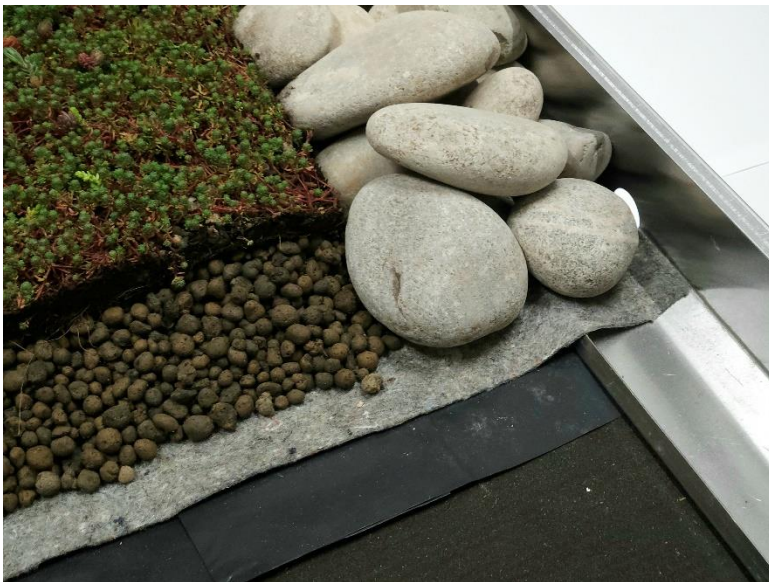

Edges and Trims



Pebble Border

Our pebbles are a functional element of our green roof system. The border is laid around the perimeter of the green roof or used to delineate areas and pathways on the roof's surface.

The pebbles come in a 20-litre bag per linear metre for a 150mm wide border. The border enhances drainage by facilitating water flow towards drainage points, preventing the

accumulation of excess water around the roof's edges.

Moreover, the pebble border helps in anchoring the edges of the green roof installation, adding to the overall stability of the sedum or vegetation blanket.

Metal Trims

Our metal trims frame the green roof, contributing to both its aesthetics and structural integrity. They come in 1 metre lengths and can be cut to size, with a height of 75mm.

They function as a barrier, securing the green roof layers in place and protecting the edges from erosion and wind uplift. This ensures the longevity of the green roof system by maintaining its form and preventing material displacement.

Additionally, the root barrier sits under the trim and the protection fleece sits inside the metal trim. The metal trims sit flat on the roof and are held in place by the pebble border with the added bonus of the trims can be used to create clean lines and define areas within the green roof for a more visually appealing design.
